#### Department 4R - Science, Engineering, Technology

- 1) General Rules and Regulations
  - a) Insects must be labeled and displayed in an attractive container. May be a photographic collection using personal photographs. Must have a least 6 insects minimum.
  - b) Science Fair Projects must follow the scientific method and only display boards should be brought for judging and display.
  - c) All entries must include a short description of scientific theory, concept or information demonstrated or presented in the project. Description should be no longer than what will fit on an index card.
  - d) Projects may include poster, displays and models. No active experimentation please.
  - e) No combustible, explosive and/or flammable materials can be used in chemistry projects.
