All Exhibitors must comply with all Washington County Ag Expo & Fair rules and regulations. Failure to comply may disqualify the entry and require that it be removed from the fairgrounds.

Department D – Swine

- 1) General Rules & Regulations
 - a) Animals not properly identified or an animal with unhealed ear notches will be ineligible for premiums.
 - b) All mature sows must show evidence of having suckled young within 12 months prior to show day.
 - c) All animals must be fed inside their pen.
 - d) All animals must be registered in the name of the exhibitor
- e) Registration certificates will be checked prior to show day.
